Our fear of course is that she will drop out of high school and not benefit from our aging out program. Whereas placing a resident in a loving home as a foster child or with a relative is their best option, we have as our goal the long-term education of the orphans in our care. Please pray that this young lady be wise in her choices going forward. We would love to provide more support to her.

#### Some Good News to Share

As most of you know Lucia Dandahuni is the Director of the Chileleko Home. She and her husband, Conald, have both worked incredibly hard to provide for the home in so many ways. Conald had been working for 27 years with one company, but due to the economic situation in Zimbabwe his company cut his pay to \$50 USD per month, and that was not always timely. Conald woke each day at 4:30 AM, worked his own garden, then found transportation to his job, often returning at 8:30 PM. Conald finally decided to quit his job and take over as Gardener at Chileleko full time (the previous gardener quit recently). This is a huge blessing for us, as Conald is a Jack of All Trades and has a giant heart. He will earn the gardener's salary which will help Lucia and him financially.
