As stated in our last newsletter, Jonathan's Impact has been providing support for the **Chilileko Home** and the food, education, and uniform budgets for **Shammah House**. We are also providing Aging Out programs for both homes.

Here are some updates from each home:

The Chilileko Home has admitted Anenyasha S. for a place of safety. Anenyasha is just over 1 year of age and was living on the street with her mother. Her mother is now a drug addict and has been admitted for rehabilitation. Anenyasha is severely malnourished and is small for her age. Generally, her condition is fair. From Lucia, our Home Director, Anenyasha is doing fairly well. *"I took her on Monday to the clinic for immunization. And after the two shots she didn't even shed a tear, it was heart wrenching. But beyond that she is coping fairly well."* More updates will be provided on Anenyasha's progress as she progresses at Chilileko.
