## Jonathan's Impact Sends Its First Shipment to Zimbabwe

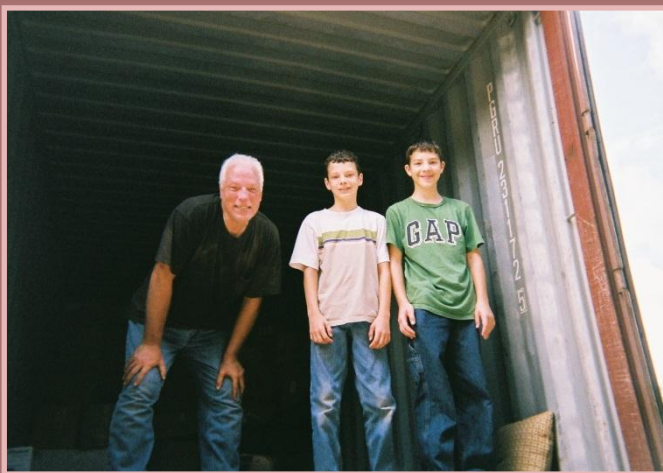

Also donated were den furniture, a tv, dvd/vcr player, and several movies for the now empty tv room at the Mbuya Nehanda Children's Home.
