New Additions to the Chilleleko Home

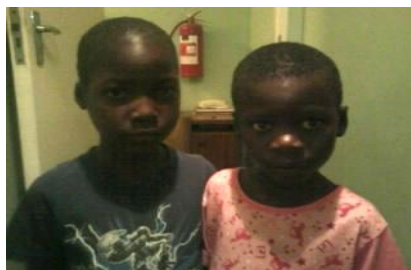
We feel blessed to announce the addition of two more children, Ella and Tanaka, to the Chilleleko Children's Home.

Jonathan's Impact helps support the Mbuya Nehanda Children's Home which houses 30-60 orphans.

The Chilleleko Home is a smaller home that house up to 12 children. Jonathan's Impact partnered with Hands of Hope to help move children from larger facilities and orphaned families to a smaller family home setting.
